Abstracts should be uploaded to via the form located at the link <http://www.dokuchaevskie.ru/2019t?lang=en> before December 20, 2018. Together with the submission of abstracts, you must upload the Agreement to the publication of abstracts, drawn up according to the presented example in the abstract submission form. Agreement must be printed, signed, scanned and downloaded in jpeg or pdf format. To upload abstracts, you will need to create a Google account if you do not have one. To do this, click the link <https://accounts.google.com/?hl=ru>.

If you want to change the title of your abstract or include new co-authors after submission, follow the link sent to you on the email provided in your application form. You will receive the letter with the link automatically after the submission of your application.

Registration fee. A registration fee is 1000 RUB (early registration (before 20.12.2018)) or 1200 RUB (late registration (after 20.12.2018)). School students don't need to pay the registration fee.

The method of payment will be indicated in the information letter No. 2.

All submitted and accepted abstracts will be published by the beginning of conference in an abstract book. The best papers will be published in a book "Materials on Russian Soils Study".
