Registration fee

A registration fee is 20\$ (early registration – **before** February 1, 2021) or 25\$ (late registration – **after** February 1, 2021).

The method of payment:

When transferring to card, do not write in the message anything except the last name of the participant for whom the payment is being made. After payment by card or by postal order, you must send a copy of the receipt (check) to the address of the organizing committee dkonf2021@gmail.com.

The registration fee includes: preparation of the original-layout, publication of a program and a collection of materials, a set of conference participants, consumable materials, sending of conference materials. If you pay one registration fee for two or more co-authors of one report, one set of participants will be issued.

If you need an official invitation to issue, please send a request to dkonf2021@gmail.com.

You must confirm your participation and form of presentation at the conference by e-mail: dkonf2021@gmail.com before February 1, 2021. In case of face-to-face conference participants book hotel reservations themselves.

Abstracts should be uploaded to via the form located at the link <http://www.dokuchaevskie.ru/abstract-submission?lang=en> **before December 30, 2020**. Together with the submission of abstracts, you must upload the Agreement to the publication of abstracts, drawn up according to the presented example in the abstract submission form. Agreement must be printed, signed, scanned and downloaded in jpeg or pdf format. To upload abstracts, you will need to create a Google account if you do not have one. To do this, click the link <https://accounts.google.com/?hl=en>.

The file with the abstract should be named by the first author last name. The file with agreement should be named «last name_agreement».

The file with the abstracts should be prepared in Word 97-2003 format. In case of using other formats, incorrect presentation of the document is possible.

If you want to change the title of your abstract or include new co-authors after submission, follow the link sent to you on the email provided in your application form. You will receive the letter with the link automatically after the submission of your application.

The conference program will be drawn up after the participants confirm their participation. The program will be presented in the second half of February on the websites: Dokuchaev's readings (www.dokuchaevskie.ru), Dokuchaev Central Soil Science Museum (soil-museum.ru),

Department of Soil Science & Soil Ecology (soil.spbu.ru). Also the conference program will be sent by e-mail to all registered conference participants.
