To participate in the conference as a speaker, fill out an **application for participation before December 6, 2021** on the conference website in the section "Participate" <u>http://www.dokuchaevskie.ru/participate?lang=en</u>.

Participants can indicate their wishes for the selection of the section, but the final distribution of participants by sections will be carried out by the organizing committee. The program of the conference will be specified after the end of the abstract submission and sent to the registered participants.

Abstracts should be uploaded to via the form located the link at http://www.dokuchaevskie.ru/abstract-submission?lang=en 20, before December 2021. Together with the submission of abstracts, you must upload the License agreement to the publication of abstracts, drawn up according to the presented example in the abstract submission form. Agreement must be printed, signed, scanned and downloaded in jpeg or pdf format. To upload abstracts, you will need to create a Google account if you do not have one. To do this, click the link https://accounts.google.com/?hl=en.

The file with the abstract should be named by the first author last name. The file with the License agreement should be named «last name_agreement».

Registration fee. A registration fee is 20\$ (early registration – before December 20, 2021) or 25\$ (late registration – after December 20, 2021)

The method of payment will be indicated in the informational letter N_2 2

The registration fee includes: publication of the program and the abstract book.

Information about the acceptance of abstracts will be indicated in the informational letter N_2 . The organizing committee has the right to select materials according to the topic of the conference.

Publication. All submitted and accepted abstracts will be published by the beginning of conference in the abstract book. The organizing committee reserves the right to make changes to the abstracts or send them for revision. The best papers will be published in a book "Materials for the study of Russian soils".

Participation in our conference will provide an opportunity to speak with results of your research in front of the scientific community, to improve the communication with the audience before defending a thesis, to get acquainted and to exchange experience with young scientists from different countries and cities of Russia.

Paper requirements:

Papers should not be more than 2 pages long. Page size A5, the size of type is 12 pt, interval between lines is single, MS Office Word format (doc, docx), margins of page are 2 cm. It is permissible to use graphs, diagrams, tables, illustrative material in black and white. The use of contrasting well-distinguishable hatching is allowed. The use of photographs is not allowed.

The *first line* is a title of paper (center alignment), *the second* – authors (center alignment), *the third* – country, city and university (center alignment), *the fourth* – e-mail (center alignment). Dear participants! Please write your working e-mail in the abstract.

The text of the abstracts is separated by one line and begins with an indent of 1 cm (width alignment)

Last line - full name, academic degree, post of supervisor

Attention please! The text of the abstracts should be designed in accordance with the specified requirements and a sample.
